- **WHD 2024 Theme: My Health My Right**
- **Elimination Round: 2nd April 2024; Final Round: 8th April 2024**
- In the context of upcoming World Health Day 2024 on April 7th, the Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM) spearheaded a nationwide undergraduate (MBBS) quiz themed "My Health, My Right" on 02nd April 2024. The event was aimed to raise awareness among future healthcare professionals about Health Rights and their role in advocating the Health Rights.
- This event recorded the participation of **26,737 medical students from 393 medical institutes** with representation from all states and union territories. Medical students from Institutes of National Importance (INI) like 15 All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research (JIPMER), Northeastern Indira Gandhi Regional Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (NEIGRIHMS) and prestigious institute like Maulana Azad Medical College (MAMC), Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC), Lady Harding Medical College (LHMC), Christian Medical College (CMCs) etc. were also part of this nationwide activity. This showcases the widespread interest of medical colleges/institutes in promoting health rights education among the medical community.

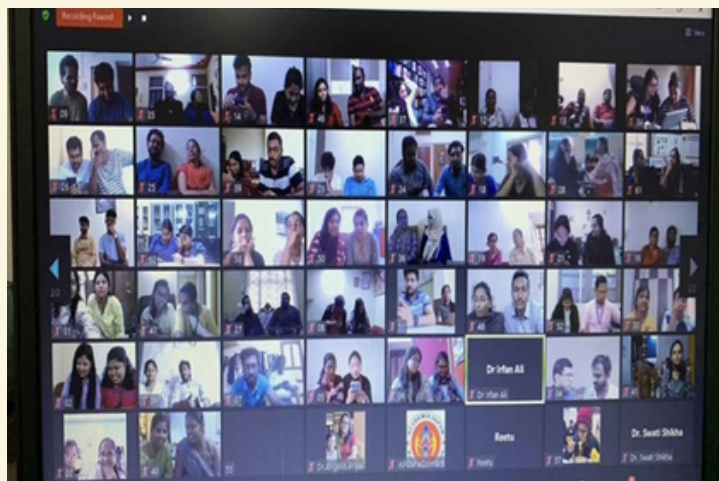

- On 07th January 2024, the Department of Community Medicine at Manipal Tata Medical College, Jamshedpur, successfully conducted the **Nationwide Online PG Quiz Preliminary Round for IAPSMCON 2024**. Led by **Dr. Jarina Begum, Professor and Head of the Department**, and her team comprising **Dr. Syed Irfan Ali, Dr. Angelin Priya, Dr. Abhishek Kumar, and Dr. Swati Shikha**, the quiz was organized in collaboration with the IAPSMCON 2024 organizing committee under the guidance of **Dr. Animesh Jain**, Professor, Department of Community Medicine, Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore.

- **Competition:** The preliminary stage saw fierce competition, with teams showcasing in-depth knowledge, teamwork, and quick responses within the allotted time. The challenging questions pushed participants to their limits, creating an exciting and thrilling test. Ultimately, **20 teams** were selected for the onsite quiz rounds at IAPSMCON 2024.

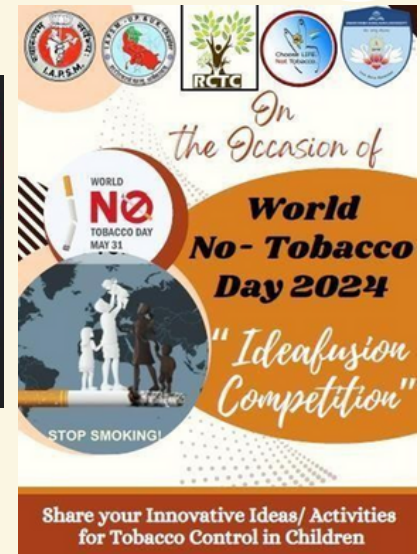
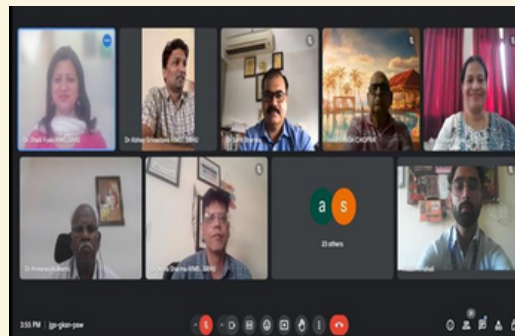
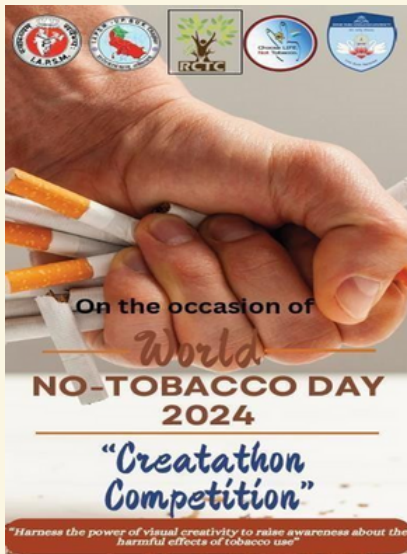
Name of the Activity: Creatathon Competition

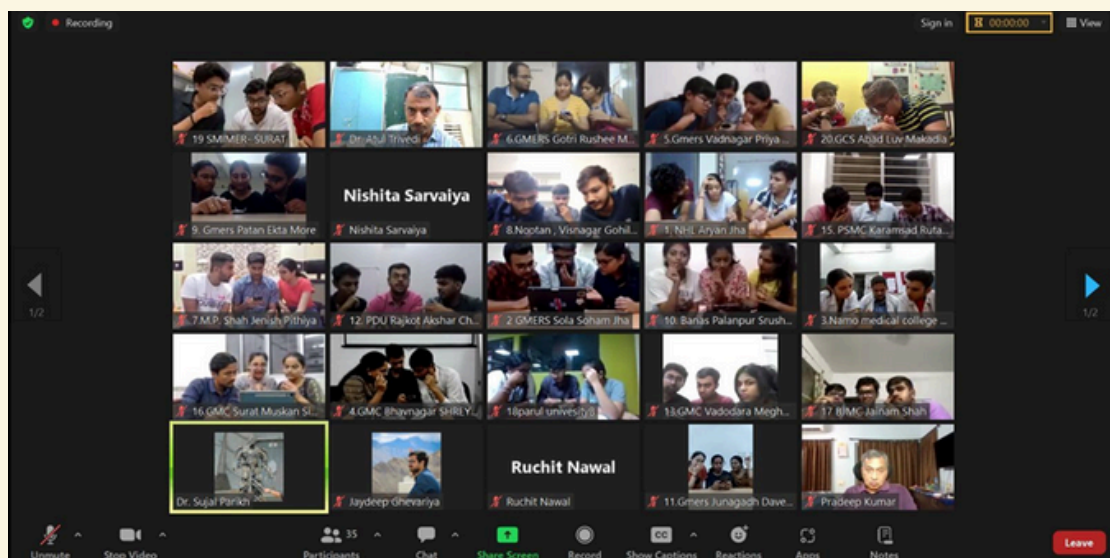

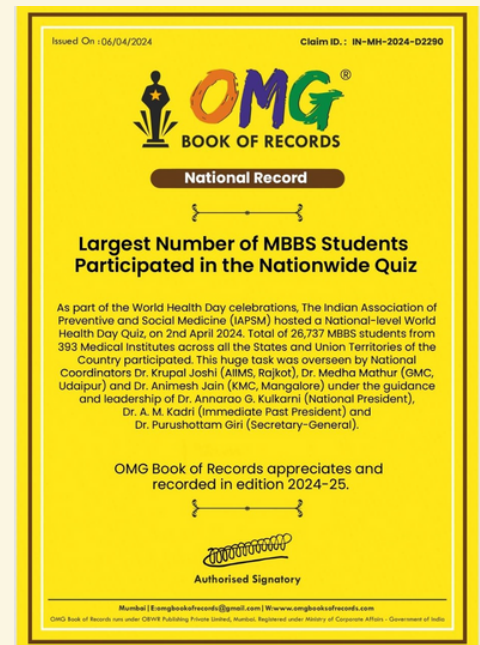

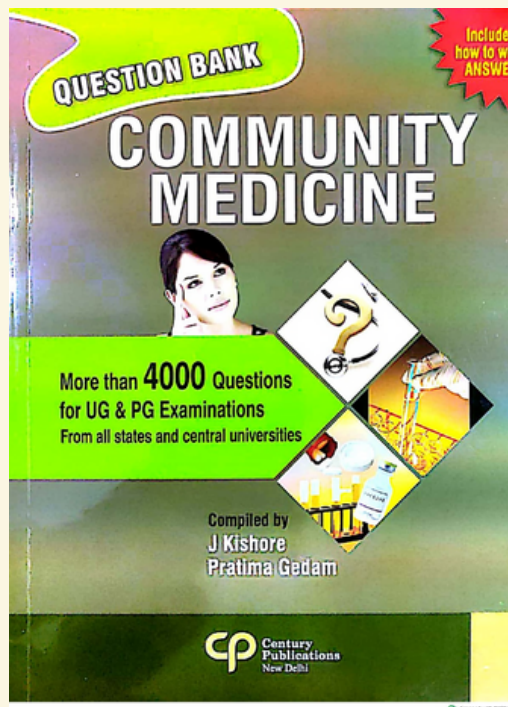
