# IAPSM Achievers

## **DR. ANAND KUMAR GOVILA,**

*M.B.B.S., M.D., F.A.M.S., F.I.P.H.A., F.I.A.P.S.M., F.I.S.C.D., F.R.I.P.H. & H. (London)*

Dr. A. K. Govila is one of the pioneers of Community Medicine. He was born on 19th Nov. 1935. Since 1973 he worked as Professor & Head, Deptt. of P.S.M. & was also Dean, G.R. Medical College, Gwalior & then Raipur. He is also Founder Director, State Institute of Health Management and Communication, Gwalior, Dean, Cancer Hospital & Research Institute, Gwalior and Project Director, Rawatpura Sarkar/ Samta Lok Sansthan Trust, Gwalior. Since 2002 till date he is working as Director, R.I.G.H.T.S. NGO.



He is the recipient of very prestigious Dhanwantari Oration Award & Dr. Mahajan Award for the first 'Best Article' in journal of IAPSM in 1980. His research contributions have been recognized by national and international bodies i.e. WHO, UNICEF, DANIDA, USAID, ICMR, NICD, NIHFWS & Nutrition Foundation of India.

He was guide of more than 35 candidates for M.D. & 6 candidates of Ph.D. and has published 45 scientific research papers in indexed national and international journals and carried out more than 60 research works till date. He has written several chapters & books for medical & paramedical health functionaries. He has completed more than 12 ICMR Projects in India. He is still working as Principal Investigator of many ICMR projects.

He successfully organized National Conference of IAPSM in 1988, M.P. IAPSMCON in 1983 and various State level workshops.

Prof. Govila has been the National President of IAPSM for two consecutive years i.e. 1986 & 1987. He is also Life Member of International Epidemiological Association, IAPSM, IPHA, IMA, Association for the Prevention of Blindness, President IMA Gwalior Branch in 1981-82 and member national body of EPI Programme.

## **DR. VINIT SHARMA,**

*M.B.B.S., M.D., PG Dip. in Health Management*

Dr. Vinit Sharma is the Senior Regional Technical Advisor for Reproductive Health & Family Planning in UNFPA's regional office for Asia and Pacific region in Bangkok (Thailand) covering 36 countries. Prior to his current assignment, he was working as Regional Advisor, Adolescent Sexual and Reproductive Health in the UNFPA's regional office for Arab States and North Africa based in Amman (Jordan). Before joining UNFPA in 2003, Dr. Vinit Sharma worked with UNICEF (India) and WHO (India) in the National Polio Surveillance Project. Dr. Sharma has more than 12 years of teaching and research experience and was working as Professor and Head of the Department of Community Medicine at PS Medical College (Karamsad, Anand), where he pioneered the concept of Youth Friendly Clinics and training of teachers for promoting the health of young people.



In 2015, Dr. Sharma volunteered for Ebola Emergency Response and worked as Senior Coordination Officer with United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response in Guinea for 6 months.

He is the first and only Indian recipient of the highest international award on Adolescent Health (the International Association for Adolescent Health - IAAH Award) and was International Vice President of IAAH for 15 years. He is also the recipient of various prestigious international and national awards and felicitations and serves on the review board of many prestigious international research journals. His services were appreciated by Govt. of Sudan & Maldives. He has more than 60 research publications in international journals and has been on the Advisory Panel and Committees for development of international guidelines and protocols. He has also contributed chapters in international text books on RH and HIV/AIDS.

He has also received advanced training in Adolescent Health & Sexuality from the University of Lausanne (Switzerland).

8. Associated with & participated in the workshop on Role of Medical Colleges in Strengthening of Urban Health in India at NIHFW in collaboration with NUHM, Govt. of India.
9. World Health Day Quiz was successfully organized on 7th April 2016 in all medical colleges across the country. Huge participation by medical students created history. The theme was "Beat Diabetes".
10. World TB Day, World No Tobacco Day, World Rabies Day, World Breastfeeding Week etc. were organized by community medicine dept. in most of the medical colleges across the country.
11. Creation of new updated IAPSM website(www.iapsm.org) with impressive look and many innovative features.
12. We have decided to bring out a multi-author Text Book of Community Medicine/ PSM with the help of IAPSM members and have already formed a committee for the same.
13. Formation of E-directory of IAPSM. Response of members is overwhelming. Work in progress.
14. Number of Fellowships increased from four to eight to felicitate more members of IAPSM excelling in academics.
15. Initiated Fellowship Programme in collaboration with CARE India i.e. Fellowship in Neonatal and Child Health and Fellowship in Reproductive and Maternal Health.
16. Started for the first time six 'National President's Appreciation Awards': two for PGs, two for young faculty and two for IAPSM members working in non-teaching areas.

## **WHO Launches 'Global Hearts', A New Initiative to Tackle Heart Diseases**

“Global Hearts”, a new initiative from the World Health Organization (WHO) and partners launched on the margins of the UN General Assembly, aims to beat back the global threat of cardiovascular disease, including heart attacks and strokes, especially in developing countries. It is a collaboration between WHO, the United States Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (US CDC), and other partners, including the World Heart Federation, the World Stroke Organization, the International Society of Hypertension and the World Hypertension League. The Global Heart Initiative will be initially rolled out in Barbados, Colombia, Ethiopia, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Jordan, Nepal, Nigeria, Philippines, Tajikistan and Uganda – and will be open to all countries wishing to participate. The initiative comprises of three technical packages:

**SHAKE** : To support governments to lower consumption of salt.

**HEARTS** : To improve management of heart diseases at the primary health care level.

**MPOWER** : To help countries implement specific provisions of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control.

## **New WHO Guidelines for Syphilis**

The World Health Organization (WHO) has published updated treatment guidelines for syphilis “WHO guidelines for the treatment of *Treponema pallidum* (syphilis)” in view of the increasing and changing antimicrobial resistance patterns of syphilis and other sexually transmitted infections. Some key recommendations include:

In adults and adolescents with early syphilis, benzathine penicillin G 2.4 million units once intramuscularly (IM) is recommended over procaine penicillin G 1.2 million units IM x 10-14 days.

In case of penicillin allergy or non availability, doxycycline 100 mg twice daily orally x 14 days or ceftriaxone 1 g IM once-daily x 10-14 days is recommended. Avoid doxycycline in pregnant women.

In pregnant women with early syphilis, benzathine penicillin G 2.4 million units once IM is recommended over procaine penicillin 1.2 million units IM once-daily x 10 days.

Benzathine penicillin G 2.4 million units IM once weekly for three consecutive weeks is recommended over procaine penicillin 1.2 million units once-daily x 20 days in adults and adolescents with late syphilis or unknown stage of syphilis.

In pregnant women with late syphilis or unknown stage of syphilis, benzathine penicillin G 2.4 million units IM once weekly for three consecutive weeks over procaine penicillin 1.2 million units IM once-daily x 20 days is advised.

Aqueous benzyl penicillin or procaine penicillin is recommended for infants with confirmed congenital syphilis or those who are clinically normal, but with mothers with untreated, inadequately treated or syphilis treated with non-penicillin regimens. Close observation is recommended for clinically normal infants and who have mothers with adequately treated syphilis treated with no signs of reinfection.
