

# **51st Annual National IAPSMCON 2024**



- The 51st Annual National Conference of the Indian Association of Preventive & Social Medicine (IAPSMCON 2024) was organized by Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal, India.
- It took place from February 8th to 10th, 2024, with pre-conference programs held on February 6th and 7th. The theme of the conference was "Transformations for achieving SDGs: Innovate, Integrate, Implement," held at the Dr. TMA Pai International Convention Centre in Mangalore.
- A total of 1186 participants registered for the event.
- The inauguration ceremony featured Dr. R Balasubramaniam, Member-Human Resources, Capacity Building Commission of India, Government of India, as the chief guest, alongside Lt. Gen. (Dr.) M. D. Venkatesh, Vice Chancellor, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, and Dr. H S Ballal, Pro-Chancellor, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, as the guest of honor and president, respectively.
- Dr. B. Unnikrishnan, Dean, Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, addressed the audience on the first day.
- The IAPSM presidential address was delivered by Dr. A M Kadri, National President of IAPSM.
- Other notable figures present included Dr. Purushottam Giri, Secretary General, IAPSM, Dr. Rekha T, Organizing Chairperson, IAPSMCON 2024, and Dr. Ramesh Holla, Organizing Secretary, IAPSMCON 2024.
- Additionally, the conference marked the 125th Birth Anniversary of Dr. T.M.A. Pai, the organization's founder.
- The conference included 57 plenary sessions and received 668 abstracts. From these, 155 papers were accepted for oral presentation and 513 for poster presentation.



#### Transforming Medical Education and Community Health: IAPSM Best Practices in Community Medicine

- A 1000-word summary of the practices was asked to be submitted under one of the 2 categories Medical Education and Field Practices.
- Life members of IAPSM (Faculty/ Senior Residents) were eligible to submit the practice, which they had conducted minimum for a span of 6 months.
- A total of 40 entries were received before the deadline, with 15 in Medical Education category and 25 in Field Practice category.
- After stringent screening by the jury members (minimum of 3 jury members screened each entry), 5 submissions in each category got shortlisted for the competition at IAPSMCON 2024
- One separate session each was given to each category of practices at IAPSMCON for selecting the best practice in each category, with jury panel of a minimum four members
- In the <u>Medical Education category</u>, Dr. Pentapati Siva Santosh Kumar received the Best Practice award and in the <u>Field Practices category</u>, it was a tie between Dr. Priti Solanky and Dr. Samudyatha UC and both were awarded the Best Practice award.
- Remaining shortlisted entries were awarded Good Practice
- Team Lead was Dr. Meenal M Thakare, Additional Professor from AIIMS Bilaspur and Member Secretary was Dr. Dhrubajyoti J Debnath, Additional Professor from AIIMS Mangalagiri.





# • CME PROGRAMME ON END OF LIFE CARE: BRIDGING HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS AND SOCIETY PERSPECTIVES

- The CME was organized by the Department of Community Medicine and Family Medicine, AIIMS Jodhpur on February 24th, 2024. Dr. Pankaja Raghav (Prof. & Head) Department of CM & FM, AIIMS, Jodhpur was the Organizing Chairperson and Dr. Neeti Rustagi (Professor) AIIMS, Jodhpur was the Organizing Secretary.
- Objectives:
  - To discuss the perspectives regarding End of Life Care among health care Professionals and to recognize issues faced in communicating with family of terminally ill patients.
  - To build consensus among health care providers regarding engaging caregivers on different aspects of EOL Care with focus on communication skills and challenges faced in initiating EOL Care.
- Total 86 participants registered and 3 main sessions including panel discussions and speeches were conducted regarding Capacity Building Initiatives for EOL care; Community Participation; and multifaceted perspectives on palliative care & End of Life Support.
- Dr Purushottam Giri, Secretary General of National IAPSM, discussed the role of IAPSM in building end-of-life care networks and focused on building community based End of Life Care for establishing culturally sensitive individualized care, in a familiar environment.



# Academia IAPSM - Workshops & CMEs under the aegis of IAPSM



#### Workshop on "CLINICAL ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE & DATA SCIENCE"

- Workshop was organized at DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY MEDICINE, Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research institute in collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi Medical Advanced Research Institute MGMARI from 22.02.2024 – 23.02.2024 at George Miller Hall, MGMCRI, SBV CAMPUS.
- Organizing chairperson was Dr Prahan Kumar, Professor & Head, Department of Community Medicine, MGMCRI and organizing members Dr Arun (Associate Professor); Dr Lokeshmaran (Associate Professor); Dr Senkadirdasan (Assistant Professor) and Dr Pavithran (Senior Resident) of Department of Community Medicine, MGMCRI.
- A total of 28 participants registered for the workshop. A total of 8 sessions were conducted in this workshop.



## IAPSM Collaborations: TSP – Tribal health Sensitisation Program

- Organised by TIDE trust in collaboration with IAPSM.
- TIDE trust is a public charitable trust registered in 2003 for the upliftment of the poor and needy tribal people.
- The work of the trust focuses on areas related to healthcare, education, income generation and microcredit groups, promotion of rural technology, deaddiction etc.
  With projects spanning in 16 states of India, the largest projects are in Assam(1800 villages) and Gujarat(800 villages).
- Since last 3 years, TIDE has started working with the Mushar community(a neglected and poor community) of Bihar as well. The healthcare work is implemented through a network of trained paramedical workers and outreach camps and referral linkage with hospitals.



- In the current undergraduate and postgraduate medical curricula, a first-hand practical exposure to the ground realities of tribal health issues is lacking. While there may be a desire to work or at least explore working in tribal areas among the young medical students; several anxieties and ambiguities about various aspects such as quality of life, professional growth, peer networks, etc. exist.
- As a result, the passionate young medical student/professional may not even venture on this path and the scarcity of medical doctors in such areas shall continue to exist.
- In order to find a solution for this and provide a platform for exploring this important needy area, this program has been designed especially for the postgraduate students of Community Medicine.
- The program objectives are as below -
  - 1. Giving a lived experience of staying with a tribal community
  - 2. Exploring the inner self and connecting with the nature
  - 3. Building connections with like-minded peers and professionals who have done innovative work in tribal health
- The program shall include a wide range of activities such as those listed below. The activities shall be conducted in an informal and non-hierarchical manner. Spending a day in a tribal home, Listening to stories of professionals who have chosen unconventional career paths for contributing to tribal health TIDE trust, -Introspection and reflections activities for understanding the self, Observing the field activities of TIDE trust working in more than 500 tribal villages of Dang district of Gujarat & Nashik district of Maharashtra for more than 15 years, Adventure activities Trekking, staying in the forest, star gazing.
- The program will be organised from 4th March 24 to 9th March 24. First day of the program(4/3/24) shall be the reporting day and the last day(9/3/24) the departure day.

## IAPSM Collaborations: IAPSM- ECHO India Roundtable Discussion



#### "Multi-Stakeholder Consultation to Reimagine Immunization and Family Adoption Program in Medical Colleges"

- Saturday, 02 March 2024 | Venue: The Suryaa, New Friends Colony, New Delhi.
- The meeting started with the National Anthem.
- Dr. Haresh Chandwani, General Manager of ECHO India, extended a warm welcome to the audience gathered. The event featured various panel discussions where participants could learn from each other's insights.
- After inauguration, Dr. Haresh Chandwani gave ECHO India's journey and overview. Established in 2008, ECHO India aims to democratize knowledge and improve healthcare outcomes for underserved populations across India.
- Over the years, ECHO India has initiated several capacity-building programs in partnership with prominent institutions such as NIMHANS, NICPR, and NITRD. He underlined Notable milestones like involvement with various public health projects like NTEP, ayushman bharat etc. Dr Annarao Kulkarni, President-elect, IAPSM gave an overview about reimagining family adoption program and immunization in medical colleges. And proposed establishing dedicated specialist immunization clinics, including for adults in every medical college ideally under purview of community medicine. Dr. Narayan Holla, Professor Emeritus at KVG Medical College, Karnataka, shared his experience with vaccination clinics. Dr. Subodh Gupta Professor and Head of Community Medicine at MGIMS, Wardha provided insights into the Village Adoption Program, which was initiated in 1969. And how Medical students undergo training across various domains including clinical, evidence-based, socio-political, and personal aspects through involvement.
- Panel discussion I on the topic "Vaccination Life Cycle Approach and Medical College" Chaired by Dr. Annarao Kulkarni and Moderated by: Dr. Meenal Thakre. Dr. Annarao Kulkarni, emphasizes the importance of a life cycle approach to immunization, stressing that vaccination is just one aspect of the process; conversion to immunity is crucial. Overall, the panel advocates for a comprehensive approach to vaccination, involving education, research, policy advocacy, and collaborative efforts across medical institutions and sectors to improve immunization coverage and access.
- Panel Discussion II on "Experiences, Challenges, and Future Directions for Dedicated Vaccine Clinics" Chaired by Dr. Purushottam Giri and Moderated by Dr. Haresh Chandwani, and Dr. Subodh Gupta, overall underscored the importance of quality services, community engagement, and partnerships in addressing challenges and maximizing the impact of dedicated vaccine clinics.


